Eversource's "317" electric distribution line right-of-way beginning at the Oak Hill Substation and ending at Sewalls Falls rd in Concord

## WHEN

March 2021 - December 2021

## SCOPE OF WORK:

Eversource contractors will be clearing our right-of-way to its full width.



## HOURS OF OPERATION:

Expect tree crews to be working in the right-of-way between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

## THE REASON FOR OUR WORK:

During a typical year, trees are responsible for approximately 25 percent of all electric service interruptions. When a storm with high winds or heavy snow comes through New England, more than 90 percent of the outages on Eversource's electric system are caused by trees and tree limbs. To help ensure reliability and public safety, Eversource hires tree-pruning and clearing contractors who remove interfering branches and trees on a regular, rotating schedule. Eversource's transmission rights-of-way are especially critical to your electric service because they carry power from a generation source to serve many customers along the electric distribution system that's located along your community's main streets and back roads.

Maintaining a safe, reliable electric transmission system that supports the environment is a top priority for Eversource. We follow federally-required best management practices in pruning, cutting, and removing tall-growing trees, and selected invasive shrubs, on all of our transmission corridors.
