The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Christ the King Church (CKC) is located at 60-72 South Main Street; and

WHEREAS, for forty (40) years, CKC has operated a food pantry in a former residential

structure at its campus; and

WHEREAS, the existing facility is inadequate; and

WHEREAS, CKC desires to construct a new 9,500+/- square foot food pantry at its

campus; and

WHEREAS, Community Development funds in the amount of \$750,000 are available

through the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development Block Grant Program Division, to assist such

projects; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the

Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter

requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

That the City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant documents and to accept, administer, and spend said CDBG funds for the purposes described herein upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
- 5. Upon approval of the CDBG application, City Manager is authorized to execute any documents which may be necessary to effectuate the CDBG contract and any amendments thereto.
- 6. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 7. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
