AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-1, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Schedule XVIII

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-1, Stopping, Standing and Parking, Section 18-1-16, Handicapped Parking, by amending Schedule XVIII, as follows:
