RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO-HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIXTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$259,062) THROUGH THE 2024 NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY, STATE HOMELAND SECURITY COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE

PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A MODULAR VEHICLE BARRIER SYSTEM FOR THE PROTECTION OF CROWDS AT PUBLIC GATHERINGS IN

CLOSED ROADWAYS.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Fire Department received notification from the State of New

Hampshire announcing the PROSPECTIVE Federal Fiscal Year 2024 Homeland

Security LOCAL competitive grant process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to purchase a modular vehicle barrier system to

physically protect crowds gathered in closed roadways during public gatherings;

and

WHEREAS, the City has found and evaluated a system that would meets its needs; and

WHEREAS, the specified system can be expanded with additional units in the future and

maintain full compatibility with existing modules; and

WHEREAS, there would be no required matching funds from the City of Concord if this

grant were awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord could substantially benefit from this equipment.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to apply for funding through the State of New Hampshire Federal Fiscal Year 2024 Homeland Security competitive grant process.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
