RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR UP TO SIX

HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$650,000) REPRESENTING EIGHTY PERCENT (80%) OF REPLACEMENT COSTS FROM THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF QUALIFYING UNITS IN THE MUNICIPAL FLEET

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

Whereas, the City of Concord continues to support initiatives and policies that promote cost efficiency

and environmental sustainability; and

Whereas, modernization of the municipal fleet results in both long-term cost savings and measurable

reductions in harmful emissions, and

Whereas the City of Concord's General Services Department has identified eligible opportunities to

pursue funding for fleet upgrades through the Granite State Clean Fleets program, administered by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to apply for up to Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$650,000) in grant funding through the Granite State Clean Fleets Program, representing Eighty Percent (80%) of eligible replacement costs, for the purpose of replacing qualifying units in the municipal fleet and furthering the City's environmental sustainability and operational efficiency goals.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
