SUBJECT: Reappointments to the Library Board of Trustees

Background

I hereby propose the re-appointment of the following individuals to the Library Board of Trustees:

- Elizabeth Mulholland would be appointed for an additional three-year term to expire on May 1, 2018. Ms. Mulholland has served on the Library Board of Trustees since 2011 and serves as the Board's secretary.
- Lisa Calgaard Sands would be appointed for an additional three-year term to expire on May 1, 2018. Ms. Sands has served on the Library Board of Trustees since 2008. She is an English Professor who volunteers in the Concord School District and at the Concord Public Library.
- Jeremy Clemans would be appointed for an additional three-year term to expire on May 1, 2019. Mr. Clemans was appointed to the Library Board of Trustees in 2012. He is an active member of the Concord community.
- **Megan DeVorsey** would be appointed for an additional three-year term to expire on May 1, 2019. Ms. DeVorsey was appointed to the Library Board of Trustees in 2010. She is an active member of the Concord community on both the local and State level.
- **Michael Alberici** would be appointed for an additional three-year term to expire on May 1, 2019. Mr. Alberici was appointed to the Library Board of Trustees in 2014. He is a school music teacher and active member of the Concord community.
