I am writing to you in your capacity as a member of Concord's Transportation Policy Advisory Committee to request relocation of the CAT bus stop now located between 214 and 220 N. Main Street. I am a shareholder of Gallagher, Callahan & Gartrell, PC, a longstanding tenant at 214 N. Main, and a member of GCG Realty, LLC, the parent company-owner of both parcels. The bus stop is currently located between our parcels and alongside our entry driveway.
