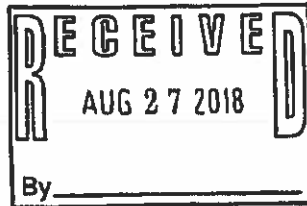

Please let me take this opportunity to thank you and the City of Concord for your invaluable support of the downtown Concord public art initiative. As you know, we now have six new installations (for a total of eight) between Theater Street and Centre Street. These pieces are leased for a year and if any of them sell, the City will collect a 30% commission towards the purchase of permanent public art in Concord. The total cost for this year's art is under \$3,000 for the 6 leased pieces, so we are well within budget. The Chamber's Creative Concord committee has been proud to coordinate this program.

I also wanted to thank and recognize Concord General Services for all of their assistance, particularly in some of the more challenging installations. Jim Major, Kevin and their team were fantastic to work with and they made some tricky installations go without a hitch. We are so grateful for their hard work, accommodation and professionalism.
