**Subject:** Appropriation for CIP #63 – Green Street Community Center Exterior Door Replacement

### **Recommendation**

Accept this report and approve the attached resolution appropriating \$10,000 for the replacement of the Green Street Community Center exterior doors.

### **Background**

The existing doors at the Green Street Community Center were installed almost 15 years ago. They were adequate for the routine users of the community center's basketball court, but are nearing the end of the service life of that grade of door. Now the community center uses and traffic through the exterior double doors has expanded. The facility is no longer primarily just a venue for basketball, but rather includes other activities like pickle ball and other after school activities. The most significant upgrade to the facility has been to provide permanent office and storage space for the Information Technology (IT) department and IT training classrooms for City staff. This Capital Improvement Program (CIP) subproject was listed in the approved Fiscal Year 2021-2030 CIP as an asterisked project, which requires council's separate approval of this appropriation.

### **Discussion**

The replacement doors will be more robust to account for the increased traffic flow and the added security requirements for the IT department. The doors will also be code compliant, with respect to crash bars, and power assist on the opening.
