**SUBJECT:** Municipal Airport Deauthorization Resolution - CIP # 77 Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Building, 10 Wheel Dump Truck

### **Recommendation**

Accept this report and attached resolution rescinding the appropriation of \$12,500 in the Airport Capital Transfer Funds in the FY 2020 CIP#77 Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) Project.

### **Background**

The City applied for a grant in the spring of 2020 to NHDOT to purchase a dump truck and plow attachments (front plow and right and left wing plows). The requested funding up to \$250,000 of which 90% is the federal share (\$225,000) and 5% is City and State share (\$12,500 each) is programmed in the FY 2020 Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

The City was notified in April 2020 by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, Bureau of Aeronautics that the 2020 Federal Cares Act Group 1 funding was allocated to cover the cost of both the City and State shares (totaling 10% of the matching funds) for all approved 2020 Airport Improvement Projects.

### **Discussion**

The purchase of the programmed dump truck and plow attachments for use at the municipal airport in the amount up to \$250,00 will now be 100% federally funded (90% from FAA Airport Improvement Program and 10% Federal Cares Act Group I program).

This resolution will rescind the \$12,500 city match as originally programmed and appropriated in the FY 2020 CIP.
