

# CITY OF CONCORD

**RESOLUTION** APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$34,000) IN THE DOWNTOWN COMPLETE STREETS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CIP #460) TO PURCHASE CONCRETE BARRIERS TO FACILITATE OUTDOOR DINING ACTIVITIES IN ON-STREET PARKING SPACES AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$34,000) FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT RESERVE FOR THIS PURPOSE

**The City of Concord resolves as follows:**

**WHEREAS,** in 2020 the City, due to the Covid-19 Pandemic and emergency orders limiting indoor dining at restaurants associated therewith, implemented a program that authorized restaurants within the Downtown Central Business District to encumber on-street parking spaces for outdoor dining activities; and

**WHEREAS,** emergency orders associated with the Covid-19 Pandemic expired in June 2021; however, the City has continued to permit use of on-street parking spaces for outdoor dining activities; and

**WHEREAS,** the City desires to purchase concrete “jersey” barriers to enclose dining areas located within on-street parking spaces; and

**WHEREAS,** funding for this purpose is available in the Economic Development Reserve; and

**WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1) The sum of.....\$34,000  
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

General Capital Project Fund

Downtown Complete Streets Improvement Project (CIP #460).....\$34,000

2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

General Capital Project Fund

Economic Development Reserve .....\$34,000

3) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.

4) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
