SUBJECT: Authorization to Accept Monetary Gift for the purchase of 47 international flags to be displayed on Main Street

Recommendation

It is recommended that City Council approve the acceptance and expenditure of this gift to the City of Concord for the purpose indicated.

Background

Mr. and Mrs. Stephen and Susan Duprey have offered to purchase 47 international flags to be hung on the City's lamp posts on Main Street in conjunction with the annual Multicultural Festival.

Discussion

The donation of \$2,443.06 is for the purchase of 47 international country flags and ancillary supporting poles and hardware. The flags will be stored by the General Services Department to be displayed annually around the time of the Multicultural Festival.

City staff has consulted with the local VFW and will be installing the flags in accordance with proper U.S. flag protocol.

These funds are requested to be expended under the authority established pursuant to Resolution #8120, adopted December 10, 2007.

The purpose of the gift is consistent with, and presents no conflict or obstacle to, the accomplishment of City Council goals, the Code of Ordinances, or the operating functions of the City.

No City match is required.
