

# CITY OF CONCORD

**RESOLUTION** APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NINETY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$90,260) FOR THE DESIGN AND PERMITTING OF THE MERRIMACK RIVER GREENWAY TRAIL (CIP #543) AS A TRANSFER IN FROM THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT RESERVE

**The City of Concord resolves as follows:**

**WHEREAS,** the fiscal year 2021 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) #543 recognizes the need to design and permit the Greenway Trail in fiscal year 2023; and

**WHEREAS,** the Parks and Recreation Department identified the opportunity to fund the design and permitting of the Greenway Trail from Loudon Road to Terrill Park in this fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS,** the design and permitting of this section of the trail would provide a “shovel ready” project should grant funding become available; and

**WHEREAS,** the design and permitting of the trail section over wetlands known as the “Boardwalk” section may take longer to design and permit or may need to be re-routed and was funded as part of the fiscal year 2020 CIP; and

**WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2021 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of .....\$90,260  
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

General Capital Project Fund

2021 Merrimack Greenway Trail subproject (CIP #543).....\$90,260

- 2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

General Capital Project Fund

Transfer in from Community Improvement Reserve .....\$90,260

- 3) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 4) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
