SUBJECT: 2026 Concord Regional Crimeline Grant Application

Recommendation - Through the City Manager, authorize the Police Department to apply for grant funding through the 2026 Concord Regional Crimeline Grant Program. If awarded, funds from this grant will be used by the Department to purchase specialized, highly mobile, rapid-deployment field equipment designed to better support a fully functional, self-sustaining investigative off-grid command post.

Background – The Concord Regional Crimeline provides grant funding to member agencies for projects that promote community engagement and community safety initiatives. The Concord Police would like to utilize funding provided through this no-match-required grant program to purchase a small, heated, portable enclosure to serve as a remote investigative off-grid command post, a portable power supply, and battery-powered crime scene lights to more effectively process crime scenes off-grid.

Discussion – This grant will allow for the Concord Police Department to purchase crime scene equipment designed for rapid deployment in remote areas of the City. It is recommended that the City Council authorize the Department to apply for up to \$3,000 in grant funding through the Concord Regional Crimeline.
