What we've done!

- ✓ City/FMRGT partnership has raised over \$2 million
 - \$1,375,000 in grants to the City
 - > \$695,000 in donations/grants to FMRGT from over 475 individuals, companies, foundations
- ✓ We have contributed \$449,550 to the City.
 - > \$84,000 for the boardwalk
 - > \$3,250 for the Pan Am appraisal
 - > \$62,300 for Terrill Park
 - > \$300,000 for the Sunflower Field Section

- ✓ We have donated hundreds of volunteer hours
 - Removing debris
 - Removing invasive species
 - Building kiosks in Terrill Park and the sunflower fields.
 - Holding nature walks, snowshoe walks, and family-oriented triathlons
- ✓ Terrill Park, I/3 mile, 9 years
- ✓ Sunflower Field Section, 3/4 mile, 13 years




