SUBJECT: FY 2026 Event Funding

Recommendation

It is recommended that City Council accept this report.

Background

In the FY 2026 City Budget, City Council allotted \$150,000 for event funding, to be distributed to organizations holding new and free public events in Concord.

Discussion

The City has received several requests for event funding. A committee made up of City staff have met and reviewed proposals. To date, the following funding has been awarded:

- Creative Guts Short Film Festival (Red River Theatres): \$3,750
- Northeast Coffee Festival (Wayfarer Coffee Roasters): \$15,000
- NH Book & Literary Festival: \$15,000
- First Friday (Intown Concord): \$6,000
- Community Concerts (Capital Center for the Arts): \$10,000
- Holidays at the Estate (Kimball Jenkins): \$15,000
- 250/300 Semiquincentennial & Tri-Centennial Celebration: \$20,000

TOTAL: \$84,750
