Hi Meredith,

Thank you for meeting with us today. It was great to talk about the process and the concerns we have about plowing our sidewalk during the winter months.

To summarize:

Beginning at the corner of North State street and Beacon street there is strip of sidewalk that the city has not been able to regularly plow.

Jim Major explained that when there are cars parked on side of the road, in front of our condo unit- 1, 1.5, and 3 Beacon st, the sidewalk snow plows are not able to throw the snow in the road. They are also not able to throw the snow in the opposite direction, because the building directly abuts the sidewalk with a range of 15-30inches of landscaping in between.

It is important for this section of sidewalk to be clear during the winter months. Without the sidewalk being cleaned, it does not allow for a safe egress for the owners and tenants.

It is also commonly used for mail, deliveries and by other neighbors and residents. We believe it is in the best interest of all people using the sidewalk, as well as the residents on this side of Beacon street, that parking be prohibited during the winter months of January through March. This will allow the City to remove the snow from our sidewalk during a winter storm.
