**SUBJECT:** Municipal Work Zone Agreement with NHDOT

### **Recommendation:**

Accept this report authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) for its resurfacing of US Route 3 from Skyview Terrace in Pembroke to just south of Airport Road in Concord.

### **Background**

In a January 24, 2018 letter, NHDOT informed the City that the Department will be resurfacing US Route 3 from Skyview Terrace in Pembroke to just south of the Airport Road intersection in Concord. Work is expected to occur after mid-June and be concluded prior to early September. City Engineering staff will be invited to the pre-construction meeting.

### **Discussion**

As part of their protocol, NHDOT requests that municipalities enter into Municipal Work Zone Agreements that stipulate that the Department will be responsible for the management and operation of the highway during construction, including the authority to determine the most appropriate way to control traffic within the construction work zone.
