RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) AND ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT PROCEEDS OF UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT HOUSING AND PUBLIC FACILITIES FUNDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS AT A MANUFACTURED HOUSING PARK LOCATED AT 190 MANCHESTER STREET

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the City of Concord is eligible to apply to the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development Block Grant Program Division, for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); and
- WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to continue its Community Development efforts by performing Community Development projects, including, but not limited to: providing housing rehabilitation assistance to low and moderate income individuals or families, as well as construction and rehabilitation assistance for Public Facilities that will provide jobs and services for low and moderate income individuals or families; and
- WHEREAS, Community Development funds are available through the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development Block Grant Program Division, to assist such projects; and
- WHEREAS, the 190 Manchester Street Manufactured Housing Park Co-operative proposes to utilize these grant funds in order to repair and replace deteriorated infrastructure, including, but not limited to, sanitary sewer and potable water systems and related infrastructure; and
- WHEREAS, the 190 Manchester Street Manufactured Housing Park Co-operative shall be responsible for raising the required matching funds to support this grant application; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$500,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

CDBG Fund

190 Manchester Street Manufactured Housing Park\$500,000

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

CDBG Fund

CDGB Housing and Public Facilities Funds\$500,000

3. The City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant documents and to apply for, accept, administer, and spend said CDBG funds for the purposes described herein, upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
4. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
