AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title V, Administrative Code; Chapter 30, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title V, Administrative Code; Chapter 30, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions by amending Section 30-3-15, Airport Advisory Committee, as follows:

30-3-15 - Airport Advisory Committee.

- (a) The Airport Advisory Committee shall consist of [~~eight (8)~~] **nine (9)** members to be appointed as follows:
- (1) [~~Eight (8)~~] **Nine (9)** members shall be nominated by the Mayor and subject to approval by the City Council.
 - a. One (1) member representing the residential neighborhood in the vicinity of the airport;
 - b. Two (2) members representative of the Concord business community;
 - c. One (1) member representing an aviation-oriented industry;
 - d. [~~Two (2)~~] **Three (3)** members representing the general public, at least one being an aircraft user at the airport.
 - e. Two (2) City Councilors.
 - (2) The City Manager or Deputy City Manager-Development as ex officio nonvoting members.
- (b) In the first instance, the appointments of the members representing the business community shall be for a three-year term, the industry representative for a two-year term, and the members of the general public for a one-year term. Thereafter, appointments shall be for a term of three (3) years. The Council representatives shall serve a two-year term.
- (c) The committee shall recommend to the City Council:
- (1) Policy for planning and development of the airport;
 - (2) Rules and regulations for the operation of the airport;
 - (3) Fees and charges;

- (4) Requirements for the proposal solicitation [sic] for the selection of a Fixed Base Operator; and the Committee shall act as a selection committee to recommend a Fixed Base Operator to the City Manager;
- (5) Review the annual budget for proposal to the City Manager.

SECTION II: This ordinance shall take effect on adoption.
