TERRILL PARK (CIP #59)

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the city desires to build needed improvements at Terrill Park (CIP#59); and

WHEREAS, the new park master plan is already fully designed and permitted; and

WHEREAS, phase one of the park master plan has already been built; and

WHEREAS, additional funding is critical to facilitate the next phase of the Terrill Park

Master Plan; and;

WHEREAS, these park improvements are scheduled in FY28 in the cities Capital

Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Outdoor Recreation Legacy Partnership (ORLP) grant program provides

nationally competitive matching grants up to \$10 million dollars per project to

cities for park projects in underserved communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for the ORLP Grant for the construction of a portion of Terrill Park, as well as to execute any and all documents therewith.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
