RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT FOR UP TO EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$8,500) WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT), BUREAU OF AERONAUTICS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF UPDATING THE STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN AT THE AIRPORT.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) signed and issued the 2021 National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP) for industrial stormwater discharges on January 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 MSGP will become effective on March 1, 2021 and will replace the 2015 MSGP; and

WHEREAS, the airport is a facility that is regulated by this permit for stormwater discharge; and

WHEREAS, the City's grant application for this purpose has been accepted, project funding will be allocated as follows; \$7,650 (90%) Federal share, \$425 (5%) State and \$425 (5%) City share; and

WHEREAS, Resolution #9369 approved at the April 12, 2021 City Council meeting authorized the City Manager to apply for a grant in the amount up to \$8,425; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Advisory Committee recommends that the City Council accept this grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council has authorized the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application to the NHDOT, Bureau of Aeronautics.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
