**RESOLUTION** MODIFYING THE BLIND EXEMPTION FOR THE CITY OF CONCORD PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF RSA 72:27-a

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- **WHEREAS,** RSA 72:37 provides conditions for the Blind Exemption and for adoption and modification of the Blind Exemption;
- **WHEREAS**, RSA 72:37 gives the City Council the authority to adopt an exemption amount;
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Concord currently provides the Blind Exemption in the amount of \$120,234; and
- **WHEREAS**, in accordance with RSA 72:27-a, municipalities may adopt or modify the Blind Exemption upon the affirmative vote of the governing body.

## **NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Concord that:

- A. The City of Concord re-adopts the provisions of RSA 72:37; Blind Exemption.
- B. The exemption from property tax in the City of Concord for those properties whose owners qualify for the blind exemption shall be \$125,000.
- C. This Resolution shall take effect on April 1, 2024.
