WHEREAS,	the reimbursement from insurance for this accident was \$8,000; and
WHEREAS,	this traffic signal pole is in the City's Capital Improvement plan for replacement; and
WHEREAS,	the light pole was not able to be replaced "in kind" so a temporary repair was made until the capital program is approved; and
WHEREAS,	the funds received can help support the traffic signal pole capital item when approved; and
WHEREAS,	on August 15, 2019 General Services Vehicle #904 was involved in an accident and totaled; and
