**SUBJECT:** Tennis Court Post Replacement at Memorial Field

### **Recommendation:**

Accept this report and funding resolution and set for a public hearing in September.

### **Background**

The Parks and Recreation Department had funds approved in FY19 (CIP 557) for the painting and crack sealing of the five older courts at Memorial Field. At the time we had not requested funds to replace the posts on the five courts. We would like to replace the posts on the five courts prior to repainting the courts.

### **Discussion**

In the FY20 CIP528 (Pocket Parks) we have a project approved for \$30,000 to replace the posts and backboards at the three basketball courts in the pocket parks. I am requesting to use \$9,000 of the FY20 CIP528 to remove and replace the tennis court posts at the five old courts at Memorial Field (CIP557). This will allow the tennis posts to be removed and replaced prior to the courts being painted. However this may limit the number of basketball court upgrades we can do. We do not anticipate final cost estimates for the basketball courts to be completed until this winter with the work scheduled for spring 2020.

If approved we anticipate the work on the tennis courts at Memorial Field will be completed by the end of November.
