

# CITY OF CONCORD

**RESOLUTION** APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$73,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF OFF-SETTING PERSONNEL COSTS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ASSIGN AN OFFICER TO THE DRUG TASK FORCE AND ACCEPT THE SUM OF SEVENTY-THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$73,000) IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE ATTORNEY GENERAL’S DRUG TASK FORCE FOR THIS PURPOSE

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS,** the Concord Police Department has received notification from the State of New Hampshire Attorney General’s Drug Task Force that the City of Concord is eligible to receive \$73,000 in grant funding as reimbursement for personnel costs associated with the Department assigning an Officer to the Drug Task Force for the time frame of date of appointment through June 30, 2025; and

**WHEREAS,** the Concord City Council on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024 authorized the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the best interest of the City of Concord to assign an Officer to the Drug Task Force as part of the Department’s continuing efforts in combatting illegal drug activity in the community; and

**WHEREAS,** there is no financial match from the City required for this grant program; and

**WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:***
