**SUBJECT:** Resolution making a return and acceptance of the perambulation of the Concord – Boscawen town line.

**Recommendation**

Accept this report and approve the attached resolution making a return of the perambulation of the Concord and Boscawen town line.

**Background**

Pursuant to NH RSA 51:2, the boundary lines between the towns in this state shall be perambulated, and the marks and bounds renewed, by the selectmen of the towns, or by such persons as they shall in writing appoint for that purpose. At its June 11, 2012, regular meeting, the City Council approved a report recommending that the City Surveyor be appointed to act as the City's representative in performing the perambulations with the City's abutting towns.

**Discussion**

On November 20 and 21, 2023, the City Surveyor and Charles Niebling, Town Forester for the Town of Boscawen, perambulated the town line between the two communities. Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution making a return of the perambulation, pursuant to NH RSA 51:4. Upon approval by the City Council, the City Surveyor will work with representatives of the Town of Boscawen to record the proper information in each community's records as well as with the NH Secretary of State.
