I overheard much of the conversation they had with the woman and her kids (the man had fled) since they were talking out in the hall. In particular, the officer who spoke with the woman was incredibly compassionate, while also gently explaining her options to her; he was truly an angel for her that night. I know she took his words to heart. Additionally, the second officer was chatting with the kids and did a great job helping them calm down after witnessing a really scary fight by their parents.
