## **Recommendation**

Accept this report and recommendation from the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee to proceed with an RFP for commercial agricultural use of this land, with a five-year term and the option for four, 5-year renewals, and include in the agreement to allow the successful bidder to sublet a portion of the leased property, with the approval of the City.

## **Background**

At its regular City Council Meeting on April 11, 2022, the City Council referred the report of the Ad-Hoc Gully Hill Road Committee to the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee for further discussion and recommendation.

## **Discussion**

At its monthly meeting on April 18, 2022, the Fiscal Policy Advisory Committee discussed the report and recommendation from the Ad-Hoc Gully Hill Road Committee and recommended the following:

A motion was made and seconded to recommend that City Council proceed with an RFP for commercial agricultural use of this land, with a five-year term and the option for four, 5-year renewals, and include in the agreement to allow the successful bidder to sublet a portion of the leased property, with the approval of the City.
