RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN THE SUM OF SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$77,248) FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT RENOVATION OF RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITIES OPERATED BY RIVERBEND COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH, INC., AND ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHTY DOLLARS (\$77,248) FOR THIS PURPOSE

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS,	Riverbend Community Mental Health, Inc. is a private, not-for-profit, community-based agency whose mission is to care for the mental health services for the community; and
WHEREAS,	Riverbend Community Mental Health, Inc., provides a full range of outpatient and residential behavioral health services to residents of Concord and the surrounding region; and
WHEREAS,	the majority of Riverbend Community Mental Health, Inc.'s clients are low to moderate income persons; and
WHEREAS,	Riverbend Community Mental Health, Inc. owns several properties located in the City of Concord to fulfill its mission; and
WHEREAS,	the City was previously awarded \$386,242 of "housing" Community Development Block Grant Funds to make improvements to residential units owned by Riverbend Community Mental Health, Inc. located at 9 Fayette Street and 111 Pleasant Street, which are used to house primarily low- and moderate-income persons receiving mental health services; and
WHEREAS,	due to inflationary factors stemming from the Covid-19 Pandemic and other macro-economic factors, the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority has made available supplemental Community Development Block Grant funds in an amount of up to 20% of the original grant award (\$77,248); and
WHEREAS,	the City desires to apply for supplemental Community Development Block Grant funds to support this project; and

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WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1.	The sum of\$77,248 be and is hereby appropriated as follows:
	CDBG Fund 2021 Riverbend Housing (2GCD_BG-21RVBNDH)\$77,248
2.	Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
	<u>CDBG Fund</u> Community Development Block Grant (2GCD_BG-21RVBNDH)\$77,248
3.	That the City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant documents and to accept, administer, and spend said CDBG funds for the purposes described herein upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.

- 4. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 5. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
