RESOLUTION	APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND THIRTY-NINE CENTS (\$24,826.39) AS A TRANSFER TO THE OPIOID ABATEMENT RESERVE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND THIRTY-NINE CENTS (\$24,826.39) IN OPIOID LITIGATION SETTLEMENT FUNDS FOR THIS PURPOSE
The City of Concord resolves as follows:	
WHEREAS,	the City of Concord is one of 23 qualifying subdivisions in New Hampshire to share in the Opioid Litigation Settlement Fund Distribution; and
WHEREAS,	this settlement relates to State of New Hampshire v McKinsey & Company Inc. (Merrimack County 217-2021-CV-0073); and
WHEREAS,	the City will receive a portion of the 15% distribution amount of \$756,504.03 that is designated to be distributed to those political subdivisions in accordance with RSA 126-A:83, II; and
WHEREAS,	the City is scheduled to receive a payment in the amount of \$24,826.39; and
WHEREAS,	with this payment, the City will have received a total of \$38,251.63 to date; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
