RESOLUTION DE-AUTHORIZING THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND SIXTY CENTS (\$178,354.60) IN TRAFFIC IMPACT FEES FROM THE 2015 DOWNTOWN COMPLETE STREET SUBPROJECT (CIP #460) AND RETURNING SAID SUM TO TRAFFIC IMPACT FEE DISTRICT #3, DE-AUTHORIZING THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND **DOLLARS** (\$300,000) AUTHORIZATIONS TO INCLUDE TWO HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$290,000) FROM THE 2016 UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SUBPROJECT (CIP #460) AND TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,000) FROM THE 2017 SOUTH MAIN SUBPROJECT (CIP #460), AND REPURPOSING THE SUM OF SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND SIXTY-ONE CENTS (\$662,884.61) IN BONDS FROM CIP #460 AND CIP #281 TO CIP #65.

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the majority of construction has been completed on Main Street; and
- **WHEREAS**, some minor improvements are expected to be completed in the early part of 2017, expenses for which are included in current contract obligations; and
- **WHEREAS**, unexpended Traffic Impact Fees in the amount of \$178,354.60 are available for de-authorization and return to the respective Traffic Impact Fee Fund; and
- WHEREAS, unissued bond authorizations in the amount of \$300,000 are available for deauthorization, including general obligation bonds in the amount of \$290,000 from the 2016 Underground Utilities subproject (CIP #460), and general obligation bonds in the amount of \$10,000 from the 2017 South Main subproject (CIP #460); and
- **WHEREAS**, the remaining unexpended bond proceeds balance of \$652,884.61 from various subprojects is available to be repurposed; and
- **WHEREAS**, this appropriation repurposing bond funds requires a two thirds vote of the City Council under RSA 33:3-a, II.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
