Update on Community Center Project

Matt Walsh gave a presentation on the plans inside/outside for the new community center then opened up to RPAC for questions.

A discussion began regarding where programs would move during construction, questions regarding building construction. David thanked the Concord School District for allowing the Dept. to use Rundlett Middle School for many of our summer camps. There was how the fields will be affected if at all. David Gill indicated the final design will not affect the layout of the fields. Mary Miller asked when will construction start. Matt Walsh indicated later this spring. Everyone is very excited about the project finally moving forward.

Terrill Park Design Update

David Gill introduced Dave Fenstermacher from VHB of the Terrill Park design team. Dave F gave a presentation about the proposed layout and plans for Terrill Park. (See attached plans)

A discussion began regarding the layout, usage and construction; everyone loved the improved connection to the river. Members of the Concord Crush Lacrosse League shared their input about concerns that the turf field is available for all community use not just schools. Mary asked what the timeline for the new park is. David Gill indicated in the years budget (FY17) we have money for full design and currently phase 1 is listed in FY18 (combined city money and donations). However, this may change based on what is approved in the FY18 budget. Amelia asked if at a future meeting the committee will look at the different types of artificial turf fields. David indicated yes and that we will come back with a multi-phase plan for the new improved park.

Amelia made a motion to accept the preliminary plans and to continue with planning of the park as presented, Lauren seconded it. Approved.
