RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$28,420) FROM THE SALE OF PROPERTY AND TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$28,420) TO RESERVE FUNDS.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS,	in November 2016, the City sold an undevelopable piece of property located in Deer Park adjacent to 10 Bow Street for \$1,500; and
WHEREAS,	in December 2016 the City sold an undevelopable piece of property located adjacent to 126 Liberty Street for \$600; and
WHEREAS,	in January 2017 the City sold a piece of property located at 51 Bradley Street for \$26,320; and
WHEREAS,	the sale of these properties was unanticipated and unbudgeted and transferring these revenues to reserves (Recreation \$1,500 and Economic Development \$26,920) and may help reduce future related expenses; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2017 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
