RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NINE HUNDRED SIXTY TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR DOLLARS AND SIXTY ONE CENTS (\$962,884.61) FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING THE CITY HALL CAMPUS STEAM TO NATURAL GAS CONVERSION AND MUNICIPAL COMPLEX SIDEWALK REFURBISHMENT SUBPROJECTS (CIP #65) USING SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR DOLLARS AND SIXTY ONE CENTS (\$672,884.61) IN PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED COMPLETE STREETS IMPROVEMENT FUNDS (CIP #460 AND CIP #281), REPURPOSING ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE COMF BOILER REPLACEMENT SUBPROJECT (CIP #323), AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS AND NOTES IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$190,000).

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the City is in the process of seeking bids for the City Hall Campus Steam to Natural Gas Conversion and Municipal Complex Sidewalk Refurbishment subprojects (CIP #65) and the COMF Boiler Replacement subproject (CIP #323); and
- WHEREAS, the initial estimates of the Steam to Natural Gas Conversion subproject (\$600,000), Municipal Complex Sidewalk Refurbishment subproject (\$240,000), and COMF Boiler Replacement subproject (\$300,000) are not sufficient to complete these projects; and
- WHEREAS, the revised estimates of the Steam to Natural Gas Conversion subproject (\$1,400,000), Municipal Complex Sidewalk Refurbishment subproject (\$400,000), and COMF Boiler Replacement subproject (\$200,000) require additional funds to complete these project; and
- WHEREAS, the Downtown Streetscape Improvements project (CIP #460) and the Eagle Square Renovations project (CIP #281) have a combined unexpended balance of \$672,884.61, which may be made available for use toward the aforementioned subprojects; and
- **WHEREAS**, \$100,000 from the COMF Boiler Replacement subproject is anticipated to be available for these subprojects; and
- WHEREAS, the unmet balance of \$187,115.39 (rounded to \$190,000) is needed to be bonded for the completion of this project; and
- WHEREAS, an appropriation/repurposing of bond funds requires a two thirds vote of the City Council under RSA 33:3-a, II.

- 3) In order to meet said expenditure, the City Treasurer, with approval of the City Manager, is authorized to issue up to \$190,000 in bonds and notes of the City of Concord under the Municipal Finance Act.
- 4) The discretion of the fixing of dates, maturities, rate of interest, form and other details of such bonds and notes, and providing for the sale, are hereby delegated to the City Treasurer.
- 5) The useful life of the improvements is expected to be in excess of twenty (20) years.
- 6) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 7) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
