Subject: Street closure for the Capital City Classic 10K

Request

I am requesting approval of street closings for the Capital City Classic 10K Road Race, Saturday June 24, 2017.

Background:

Saturday, June 24, will mark the 2nd Annual Capital City Classic 10K Road Race. All proceeds benefit the Concord Coalition to End homelessness and Intown Concord. We have been working with both beneficiaries and Capital Area Race Series to ensure a successful event.

Discussion:

The Capital City Classic 10K will take place during the 3-day festival of Market Days. The race will begin on North Main Street, and finish on Park Street. Set up on June 24, 2017, will begin on North Main Street at 06:00a.m.. The race will start at 08:00a.m., and all runners will be off the city roads by 10:00 a.m., with the exception of Park Street. The event and break down will be complete by 11:00 a.m. on June 24, 2017.

Runner's Alley requests the following streets to be closed on Saturday June 24, 2017, in addition to the current Market Days street closures.

- Southbound lane on South Main Street from Hills Avenue to West Street. From 08:00a.m.-08:30a.m., or until our last runner passes West Street. It should only take 15-20 minutes for all runners to pass West Street.
- 2. Park Street from Green Street to North State Street from 08:00a.m.-10:00 a.m.

Runner's Alley will continue working with appropriate City and State Departments to arrange all proper procedures, licensing, and other requirements. Runner's Alley will notify all nearby religious facilities, Concord Area Transit, and Manchester Transit Authority of the road race date and times.

Start/Finish and all mile markers marked with P-K nails and yellow paint.

Start: On west side of N Main St 14 ft 8 inches S of Park St/One Way sign on southwest corner of intersection of Park St and N Main St, 13 ft 8 inches N of Black Double Street Lamp on sidewalk in front of the NH State House, & 1 ft S of end of white stripe marking the southern end of

the 1st parking spot on N Main St.

Mile 1: On west side of S Main St 9 ft 9 inches N of Water Line Metal Cap in the middle of the intersection of S State St and S Main St.

Mile 2: On northeast side of Broadway in front of 137 Broadway and even with an orange Fire Hydrant on opposite side on the southwest corner of Wood Ave and Broadway.

Mile 3: On northwest side of Clinton St 38 ft 8 inches NE of Storm Drain on same side that is opposite intersection of Dartmouth St and Clinton St. Mile 4: On northeast side of Langley Pkwy 11 ft NW of a Storm Drain on same side.

Mile 5: On south side of Pleasant St 11 ft E of Gale St sign which is on the southeast corner of Gale and Pleasant.

Mile 6: On east side of Green St 23 ft N of Storm Drain at NE corner of Green and School Sts.

Finish: On south side of Park St even with the center of Parking Pay Station on sidewalk & 18 ft 8 inches ENE of Storm Drain on same side.
