SUBJECT: Authorization to Accept Monetary Gift for the purchase of 100 flags to be displayed on Main Street

Recommendation

It is recommended that City Council approve the acceptance and expenditure of this gift to the City of Concord for the purpose indicated.

Background

Local residents, Stephen and Susan Duprey, offered to purchase United States and City of Concord flags to be hung on the City's new lamp posts on Main Street.

Discussion

Mr. & Mrs. Duprey donated \$3,872.50 for the purchase of fifty 3' X 5' U.S. flags and fifty 3' X 5' City of Concord flags and ancillary supporting poles and hardware.

These funds are requested to be expended under the authority established pursuant to Resolution #8120, adopted December 10, 2007.

The purpose of the gift is consistent with, and presents no conflict or obstacle to, the accomplishment of City Council goals, the Code of Ordinances, or the operating functions of the City.

No City match is required.
