The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, on September 14, 2009, City Council amended the Code of Ordinances, Title I, General Code, Chapter 5, Public Works, Article 5-1, Highways and Sidewalks (Ordinance No. 2766), which included revised permit requirements, fees and penalties, and introduced the protection of new paved streets in the form of a 5year no-cut moratorium and the assessment of street damage fees; and
- WHEREAS, in 2010, Liberty Utilities filed suit against the City claiming that the amended Ordinance was not valid under New Hampshire law; and
- WHEREAS, on June 16, 2017, the New Hampshire Supreme Court issued an order finding the City's excavation fee ordinance to be valid under New Hampshire law; and
- WHEREAS, the City wishes to recognize funds previously collected for this purpose; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2017 adopted budget, therefore, Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
