AN ORDINANCE

amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title IV, Zoning Code; Chapter 28, Zoning Ordinance, Article 28-6, Sign Regulations

## The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title IV, Zoning Code; Chapter 28, Zoning Ordinance, Article 28-6, Sign Regulations, Section 28-6-7, Signs Prohibited Under This Ordinance, Subsection (j), by revising as follows:

Projecting signs that are lower than ten (10) feet or greater than twenty-five (25) feet above grade, protrude above the sills of the windows above the first story, project more than [six feet eight inches (6'8")] five feet (5'0") from the building, and contain more than [twenty four (24)] fifteen (15) square feet of sign area;

SECTION II: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title IV, Zoning Code; Chapter 28, Zoning Ordinance, Article 28-6, Sign Regulations, Section 28-6-9, Signs Permitted in Non-Residential Districts, Subsection (d), by revising as follows:

<u>Sign Illumination</u>. No sign in the *Central Business Performance (CBP)*, Civic Performance (CVP), Institutional (IS), and Urban Transitional (UT) Districts may be illuminated from within, but may be illuminated by a shielded external light source.

**SECTION III:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
