The City of Concord resolves as follows;

- WHEREAS, on April 12, 2004 the City adopted the provisions of RSA 36-A, re-establishing the Concord Conservation Commission with the power to acquire in the name of the city, subject to the approval of the local governing body, by gift, purchase, grant, bequest, devise, lease, or otherwise, the fee in such land or water rights, or any lesser interest, development right, easement, covenant, or other contractual right including conveyances with conditions, limitations or reversions, as may be necessary to acquire, maintain, improve, protect, or limit the future use of or otherwise conserve and properly utilize open spaces and other land and water areas within the city; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) included a recommendation to purchase land or easements for the purposes as provided in RSA 36-A noted as CIP # 352; and
- WHEREAS, the Conservation Commission, under the provision of RSA 36-A, conducted a public hearing on June 13, 2018, after which the Conservation Commission members voted unanimously in the affirmative to exercise their authority with regard to obtaining the parcel legally described as: Tax Map 100 Block 2 Lot 21, consisting of approximately 8.39 acres; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Conservation Commission intends to pay for the above-cited parcel in the amount of up to \$13,400 using funds available to the Conservation Commission in the Conservation Fund; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Conservation Commission may convey a conservation easement on the above-cited parcel to a local or statewide conservation organization as a means of ensuring the permanent protection of said parcel; and
- **WHEREAS**, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2019 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
