RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT FOR UP TO TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,850,000) WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT), BUREAU OF AERONAUTICS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING PHASE 1&2 REHABILITATION OF 5000 FEET OF TAXIWAY A, CRACK SEALING AND MARKING RUNWAYS 17/35 AND 12/30 AND OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- whereas, the City of Concord is eligible to apply and receive funding for the construction of the rehabilitation, lighting and marking for Taxiway A and crack sealing and marking Runways 17/35 and 12/30 as described in the FY 2018 and 2019 Capital Improvement Program and Budget as project #468; and
- **WHEREAS**, obstructions in need of removal were identified on airport property by NHDOT as part of the annual 2017 airport inspection; and
- WHEREAS, on April 10, 2017, Resolution 8987 authorized the City Manager to apply for a grant in the amount of \$1,314,000 for the Construction of Phase I of the Taxiway A Reconstruction Project; and
- **WHEREAS**, on August 14, 2017, Resolution 9028 appropriated the amount of \$1,468,980 for the construction of Phase I of the Taxiway A Reconstruction Project; and
- **WHEREAS**, the fall of 2017, Federal Aviation Administration notified NHDOT that the City's grant application to construct the reconstruction of Taxiway A was not approved; and
- WHEREAS, on April 9, 2018, Resolution 9085 authorized the City Manager to apply for a grant in the amount of \$2,850,000 for the Construction of Phase I and II of the Taxiway A Reconstruction Project; and
- **WHEREAS**, should the City's application for Phase II of this project be accepted, project funding would be allocated as follows; \$1,278,000 (90%) Federal share, \$71,000 (5%) State and City share; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Airport Advisory Committee recommends that the City Council approve this grant application and acceptance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Council has authorized the City Manager to accept and enter into a grant with the NHDOT, Bureau of Aeronautics.

2.	This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant awarded by the New Hampshire Department, Bureau of Aeronautics.
