#### The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the Unites States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of \$22,540; and

the Concord Police Department desires to procure police equipment and training in WHEREAS. the amount of \$19,540; and

WHEREAS, there is no match required for accepting these funds; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department is entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Merrimack County to pass through the remaining \$3,000 to the County; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2019 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
