- SUBJECT: Granite Center Redevelopment Project

Recommendation:

Accept this report.

Background:

On July 9, 2018, the City Council approved Resolution #9116, which authorized the City Manager to enter into a Purchase and Sales / Development Agreement with Granite Center L.L.C.. As part of that Agreement, Granite Center agreed to pay the sum of \$145,000 to the City, as follows:

- \$95,000, which represents the sale price for the former Dixon Avenue Surface Parking Lot (City Assessor's Lot 45-6-18);
- \$30,000 to compensate the City for the net loss of six parking spaces in the Bridge Street right-of-way due to the Developer's construction of the public plaza improvements;
- \$15,000 to compensate the City for the estimated net loss of three parking spaces in the Storrs Street Public Parking Lot resulting from the Developer's private parking improvements on a licensed portion of the City's property; and,
- \$5,000 to assist with costs to restriping portions of Storrs Street to create potential onstreet parking spaces to help mitigate the loss of other public parking associated with this project.

Discussion:

The financing package and real estate transactions for the project closed on August 3, 2018 and the City has received the \$145,000 owed in full. These moneys were deposited into the Parking Fund.
