AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-3, Parking Meters, by amending Section 18-3-14, Duty of Police, as follows:

18-3-14 - Duty of Police.

It shall be the duty of the police officers acting in accordance with instructions issued by the Chief of Police, to report:

- (a) Number of Parking Meter. The number of each parking meter which indicates that the vehicle occupying the parking space adjacent to such meter is or has been parked in violation of this chapter or the number of the machine-controlled parking space that the parking time registration machine or absence of a valid machine-issued parking receipt indicates is occupied by a vehicle in violation of this chapter.
- (b) Registration Number of Vehicle. The state registration number of such vehicle.
- (c) *Time of Violation*. The time at which such vehicle is parked in violation of any of the provisions of these regulations.
- (d) Any Other Facts. Any other facts, a knowledge of which is necessary to a thorough understanding of the circumstances attending such violation.
- (e) Attach Notice of Violation. Each police officer shall also attach to such vehicle a notice to the operator or owner thereof that such vehicle has been parked in violation of this ordinance, and instructing such operator or owner to report at police headquarters.
- (f) Reserved.
- (g) Reserved. [Permit for Exclusive Use. The Chief of Police may in the Chief's discretion issue to a contractor or other person actually engaged in construction and repair work, a temporary permit not to exceed two (2) days for exclusive use of a metered parking space for the parking of a vehicle or other equipment being used in the construction or repair work. The fee for the permit per day shall be

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as listed in Schedule I of Chapter 1, and upon payment the space shall be marked with an appropriate sign or device indicating that parking is reserved. A person other than the permit holder shall not park a vehicle in a metered space that is so marked.]

SECTION II: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-3, Parking Meters, by amending Section 18-3-18, as follows:

18-3-18 - [Reserved.] Parking Encumbrance Permits.

The City Manager, or his designee, may in the City Manager's discretion issue a temporary permit for exclusive use of metered parking spaces, non-metered time zone parking spaces, or loading zone parking spaces for:

- (a) The parking of a vehicle;
- (b) Construction activities, including staging and storage of construction equipment or materials, as well as installation, repair or replacement of public and private utilities;
- (c) Special events including, but not limited to, street festivals, markets, road races, walk-a-thons, and performances; or
- (d) For any other lawful purpose.

The fee for the permit shall be per parking space per day as listed in Schedule I of Chapter 1; however, the fee for encumbering parking spaces shall be waived for those special events which are granted a Street Closure Permit from the City Manager. Upon approval of a completed application, and receipt of payment, the parking space(s) shall be marked with an appropriate sign or device indicating that the parking space is reserved. No person other than the permit holder, or a party authorized by the permit holder, shall occupy the encumbered parking space. The City Manager is hereby authorized to create permit applications, rules, and procedures to administer parking space encumbrances.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
