Subject: Repurpose funds in the amount of \$31,000 from FY 2017 Capital Improvement

Project CIP#91 Sanitary Sewer Main Rehabilitation and Construction Project to replace sewer laterals on Community, High, and Walnut Streets identified during

water line improvements.

Recommendation

Accept this report and approve the attached consent resolution.

Background

Capital Improvement Project CIP#85 included funds from the water enterprise fund to replace the existing eight inch cast iron water line on Community Drive and High Street with an eight inch ductile iron water pipe, and to replace the existing six inch cast iron water line on Walnut Street with an eight inch ductile iron pipe.

Discussion

General Services Department staff identified certain existing residential sewer services in all three streets should be replaced. This work was completed by the City's contractor, SUR Construction West, Inc. Since the work involved the sanitary sewer collection system, it should be funded by the Wastewater Fund.
