SUBJECT: Resolution providing for the supplemental appropriation of \$19,536.84 generated from the sale of timber from City-owned, non-Conservation property and transferring \$19,536.84 to the Community Improvement Trust.

Recommendation

Accept this report and set the attached resolution for public hearing.

Background

Over the last year, the City has held three timber sales from trees harvested on non-conservation lands. The harvests were for the following:

- Red pine salvage at City's former Water Tower Lot:
- Red pine salvage at Penacook Lake/Garrison Park
- Clearing for the City's Fire Training Facility

Discussion

These three timber sales generated a total of \$19,536.84 in revenue. As these dollars were not raised from conservation property, City staff recommends that the funds be transferred to the City's Community Improvement Trust.
