The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS,	in an effort to stem the propagation of damaging scale, the City salvaged red pine
	timber from the City's former Water Tower Lot in Penacook and from City
	property in the vicinity of Penacook Lake and at Garrison Park; and

- **WHEREAS,** the City also salvaged timber from the clearing of a City lot on Old Turnpike Road to be used for the new Fire Training Center; and
- WHEREAS, the timber from the aforementioned operations was sold and generated \$19,536.84 in revenue to the City; and
- WHEREAS, these funds are recommended to be transferred to the Community Improvement Trust; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2019 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:
