Dear Municipal Clerk:

New England Power Company (NEP) d/b/a National Grid intends to conduct routine maintenance and repair activities along their existing overhead electric utility rights-of-way (ROWs) in your municipality. Currently scheduled maintenance/repair work involves routine vegetation management which may include side-line tree pruning, danger tree removals, mechanical mowing of herbaceous and woody vegetation, and/or hand-cutting of vegetation within wetlands or other areas deemed environmentally sensitive. Other maintenance/repair activities which may occur this year include, but are not limited to, overhead structural work, structure replacements, structure painting, repairs to electric grounding grids, footer inspections and access road repairs. Maintenance/repair work is planned to commence in June 2019. Timber matting may be utilized to gain access across wetlands and streams in order to reach areas and infrastructure targeted for maintenance. Additionally, timber mats may be set up in wetlands to stage equipment while work is performed. In accordance with RSA 482-A:3, XV, routine utility maintenance work is exempt from the standard wetland permitting process. However, we are required to notify the municipality where the work is proposed and the NHDES Wetlands Bureau. All project work will be conducted in accordance with the Best Management Practices Manual for Utility Maintenance in and Adjacent to Wetlands and Waterbodies in New Hampshire (March 2019), published by the New Hampshire Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, and National Grid BMP documents as applicable.
