## The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS,	the Concord Police Department, in conjunction with the Merrimack County
	Sheriff's Office, desires to apply for the 2019 United States Department of
	Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Concord desires to procure additional equipment and/or training through these funds; and

#### WHEREAS, funding is available and both the Concord Police Department and Merrimack County Sheriff's Office are eligible to receive funding through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS,** there is no financial match required for this grant program.

### NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application documents.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
