whereas, the Fiscal Year 2020 capital improvement plan included the authorization and appropriation of \$30,000 in general obligation bonds for the 2020 Pocket Parks subproject (CIP #528) for new basketball posts and backboards at the three pocket parks; and

WHEREAS, the tennis court at Memorial Field (CIP #557) are due to be painted and restriped; and

WHEREAS, the tennis court posts at Memorial Field are in need of replacement and were not part of the 2020 capital plan; and

WHEREAS, unissued bond authorization from CIP #528 in the amount of \$9,000 is available for rescission and de-authorization; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work in CIP #528 will be scaled back to accommodate the rescission and de-authorization of \$9,000 of appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to fund the tennis court improvements through the issuance of bonds and notes in the amount of \$9,000; and

WHEREAS, RSA 33:9 mandates that a two-thirds vote of all members of the City Council is required to pass a bond resolution; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
